Position Overview

The Quality Control Aid will report directly to the Facility Manager. This position is responsible for assisting the Quality Control Technician with rearing activities and routine testing to ensure the production of high-quality codling moths. Time will be divided between the Quality Control Lab, as well as assisting production staff in the facility. Activities performed in this role must be compliant with established procedures, quality standards, and safety policies.

Responsibilities/Duties/Accountabilities

- 1. Assist in raising high quality codling moths
- 2. Aid with daily duties such as:
 - pH testing, longevity tests, counting eggs and % hatch
 - Monitoring conditions
 - Weighing pupae and adult moths
 - Counting pupal casings and calculating larval mortality
 - Air quality tests: making agar, monitoring, and evaluating growth colonies
- Making cages
- 4. Weighing moths/ingredients
- 5. Processing egg sheets
- 6. Processing sales orders
- 7. Maintain sanitation standards, ensuring a clean and safe workspace
- 8. Establish and maintain positive and effective interpersonal relationships
- 9. Additional duties as assigned by the Facility Manager
